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## **Rules and Conditions of Entry**

(1) The ride will be divided into three classes

**Class A:** 14 years and over on 22nd August 2010

**Entry fee: £25**

**Class B:** 14 years and under on 22nd August 2010

**Entry fee: £20**

Classes A and B will follow the same route and can ride together.

Jumps are optional.

**Class C:** Leading rein approx 3 mile ride to be ridden over a separate course with no jumps

**Entry fee: £7**

**Every finisher will receive a rosette**

(2) **Combination of horse and riders may only complete the course once.** The route will be clearly marked and will be ridden through fields. Please stay to the outside of field or marked route remembering this is a working farm and some fields may be prepared for crops.

(3) **Riders may make only three attempts at each obstacle.** There will be no elimination but after a third refusal the rider must go on to the next obstacle. Riders may retire on route but must report their retirement to the nearest steward immediately.

(4) **Hard hats** and correct footwear must be worn by all riders. Number bibs must be visible to stewards at all times.

(5) **Dogs** must be kept on leads at all times and will only be allowed in the start and finish areas and around the leading rein ride.

(6) **Riders** are asked to make sure any hay and droppings are cleared from the horsebox area before leaving.

(7) **Entries** must be made on the enclosed entry form and must reach the secretary together with appropriate fee not later than 16th August 2010. No more than four riders in one group, up to four riders may be included on one entry form.

(8) **Starting times** will be between 8.30am and 2.30pm. Requests to ride together for early or late starting times must be included on the entry form. By 19th August the starting time of each rider will be sent on a postcard to the address of the signatory on the entry form. This card must be presented at declaration. Please send a sae for start times.

(9) **Declaration** to start must be at the secretary's caravan not later than 30 minutes before the allotted start time. A £5 refundable deposited is required on the day for a number bib.

(10) **Disclaimer:** All entries must be accompanied by the correct entry fee and are received on the condition that the event organisers and land owner accept no responsibility for any loss, damage or accident that may be sustained to vehicles, horse or persons or any property what so ever while on the premises. No claims can be entered for anything that may happen to riders, horses or on lookers in connection with or arising from this ride.

Failure to carry out instruction from a Steward may lead to disqualification.

(11) **The Organisers** reserve the right to refuse entry or cancel the event due to bad weather whereby we reserve the right to retain 25% of the entry fee to defray costs. In the event of cancellation please send a sae to reclaim your entry. The decision of the organisers is final on all matters and is not negotiable.

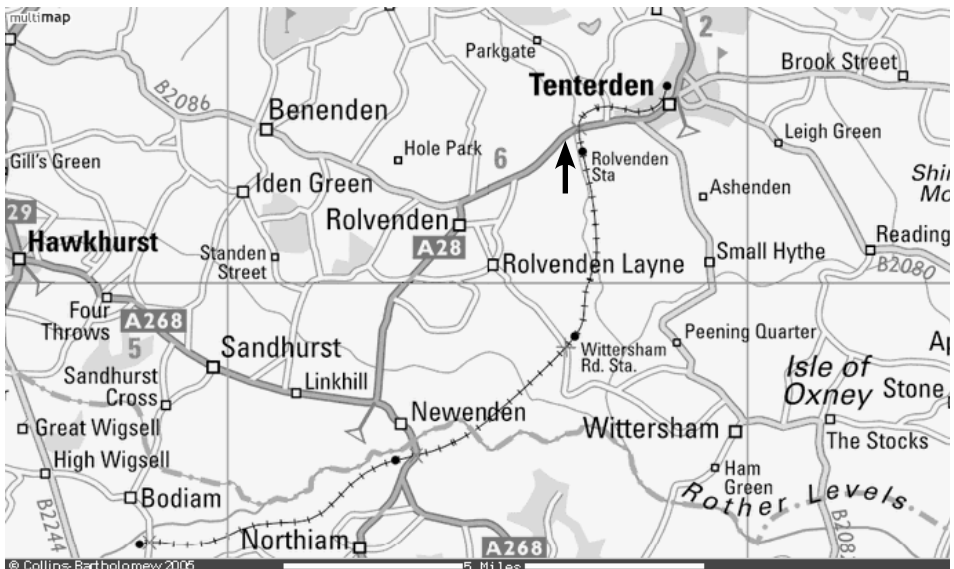
