**Class 1**                      **Fences 1ft - 1ft 6"**

**Class 2**                      **Fences 1ft 6" - 2ft**

**Class 3**                      **Fences 2ft—2ft 3"**

Class 1 & 2 will be run over a short course of 10 knockdown fences. Competitors may be led and helped. These classes will be judged on style & control—not timed.

Class 3 will be run over a course of approximately 10 fences—some of which will be fixed. Competitors are not allowed to be led but may have a helper on the course. To be judged on style & control—not timed.

## Hunter Trial Sunday 1st August 2010

**Class 1**                      **Fences 2ft 3"—2ft 6"**

**Class 2**                      **Fences 2ft 6" - 2ft 9"**

This event is a qualifier for the Finals of the BHS Cross-Country Championships 2010. In the nominated qualifying classes, the TWO highest placed riders (or two highest placed Pairs) who are BHS Gold Members ON THE DAY OF THE QUALIFIER will qualify for the Final. In the event of a combination of horse/pony and rider already having qualified, the qualification will pass down to the next eligible competitor. You must provide the Entries Secretary with your BHS membership number when you enter the qualifier but we recommend you also carry your membership card on the day. Non-members may enter qualifying classes. Competitors placed 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> who are not Gold member on the day of the competition will also have the opportunity to qualify by becoming a Gold member of the BHS up to 7 days after the qualifier date. This will not pass down and does not affect the highest placed BHS members. All competitors must have had a clear jumping round, time penalties would be allowed but competitors couldn't qualify with jumping penalties. Competitors who compete on day tickets would still be able to qualify for the BHS Cross Country Championship as long as they were not placed 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> at the BE Event prior to qualifying for the BHS Championship. Rules at qualifiers may differ from those at the Finals. Classes at the Finals will be Novice and Pairs (both max 2' 9"), and Open (max 3' 3"). ## Rules

1. Body protectors and medical arm bands **must** be worn whilst jumping. Hats to approved current standard.
2. Any competitor in difficulty at a fence must make way for the following competitor.
3. No refunds unless accompanied by a vet's or medical certificate.
4. Any objections must be made within 30mins of the end of the class & accompanied by a non-refundable fee of £10.
5. Dogs must be kept on a lead.
6. All horses must walk on the showground. There will be a working in area for faster work.
7. If eliminated, competitors may continue unless instructed to leave the course, eliminated competitors must make way for following competitors.

Error of courses not rectified	Elimination
