## Classes

### CLASS 1 - IN-HAND (10am start)

**Obedience Test - Walk & Trot only** To be performed in a 20m x 40m dressage arena and marked on accuracy and obedience of transitions rather than paces and way of going.

**Control of Paces** Horse required to trot as slowly as possible along a measured track then return in walk as fast as possible. Points given on a sliding scale. Maximum of 30 points for each pace. A break in pace results in a zero score for that pace.

**Obstacles** Ten obstacles with a maximum of 10 points at each. The obstacle course can be walked the evening before.

### CLASS 2a & 2b - NOVICE RIDDEN (follows previous class)

**Restriction - Only open to competitors who have NOT competed in a full Trec competition. Suitable for newcomers to Versatile Trec/Trec.**

**Obedience Test - (class 2a - Walk & Trot only: class 2b - Walk, Trot & Canter))** To be performed in a 20m x 40m dressage arena and marked on accuracy and obedience of transitions rather than paces and way of going.

**Control of Paces** Horse required to trot (**class 2a**) or Canter (**class 2b**) as slowly as possible along a measured track then return in walk as fast as possible. Points given on a sliding scale. Maximum of 30 points for each pace. A break in pace results in a zero score for that pace.

**Obstacles** Ten obstacles with a maximum of 10 points at each. The obstacle course can be walked the evening before.

### CLASS 3 - OPEN RIDDEN (follows previous class)

**Obedience Test - Walk, Trot & Canter** To be performed in a 20m x 40m dressage arena and marked on accuracy and obedience of transitions rather than paces and way of going.

**Control of Paces** Horse required to canter as slowly as possible along a measured track then return in walk as fast as possible. Points given on a sliding scale. Maximum of 30 points for each pace. A break in pace results in a zero score for that pace.

**Obstacles** Ten obstacles with a maximum of 10 points at each. The obstacle course can be walked the evening before.

#### CLASS 1 RULES:

1. Bridles must be worn.
2. Gloves must be worn
3. A schooling whip may be carried and voice may be used.

#### ALL OTHER CLASSES (inc CLASS 1)

4. No horse/pony under 4 years of age.
5. Riders/Handlers must wear a riding hat to standard BS4472, BS6473, BS EN 1384 or PAS015.
6. Appropriate footwear must be worn. Body protectors optional.
7. Obedience test may be read.
8. In the event of a draw, the winner with the highest PTV score wins.

## Rules & Conditions of Entry

1. **Entry fees are non-refundable or transferable except on production of a vet's/medical certificate.**
2. Bridge House accept no responsibility for any injuries or damage caused to or by any person, horse, vehicle while on the show ground.
3. The judges decision is final. Any objections must be made within 30mins of the end of the class & accompanied by a non-refundable fee of £10.
4. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
5. Correctly secured current British Standard riding hats must be worn by children 16 years and under when handling and riding ponies/horses.
6. Horses boxes and trailers must be parked in the area nominated and all litter and mess must be taken home with you.
7. The Show Secretary can refuse entry without giving reason.

### NOTES:

- We will endeavour to publish the results on the day of the competition - please leave a SAE if you would like us to post them to you. The results will be available on-line from 8pm (or thereabouts) on the evening of the event.
- Prizes/rosettes are available to 8th place and must be collected on the day of the show or from Bridge House Reception on the Tuesday after the event. Prizes/rosettes cannot be posted.
- Depending on numbers, late entries may be accepted.
- Refreshments available.
